

Fabric book cover – simple notes

Book Cover

Cutting

Cut one Book Cover Outer from fabric
Cut one Book Cover Outer from iron on Parlan
Cut one Book Cover Lining from calico or similar

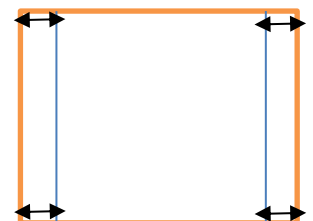
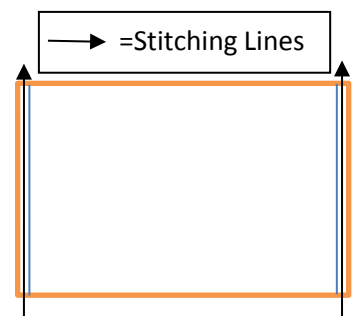
Preparation

Iron the Parlan onto the wrong side of the Book Cover Outer piece, ensuring that it is well stuck down and sitting flat.

Stitching

Turn under (**towards the wrong side**) one 1cm on each short end of the Book Cover Outer piece and stitch in place.

With **right sides together** fold in these short ends to the mark on the pattern and stitch down, taking a 1cm seam and starting and finishing with a reverse stitch.



Without turning the corners through place, the calico lining on top, right sides together. Please note that the fabric will not go right through to the corner, it will be shorter. Stitch the lining down on each of the long sides, taking a 1cm seam allowance.



Turn the book cover, right side out and push the corners out. Press the top and bottom edges so the seam is slightly rolled towards the lining. Place the book inside and you are finished!
