Knitting Classes

Knitting Group Friday Mornings

This is a knitting group/class where anyone can come along with their knitting project to receive guidance and tuition as they create an article of their choice. These sessions will be most suited for beginners to intermediate level however, all skill levels are most welcome. Both knitting and crocheted projects can be completed.

Sewing Machine Classes

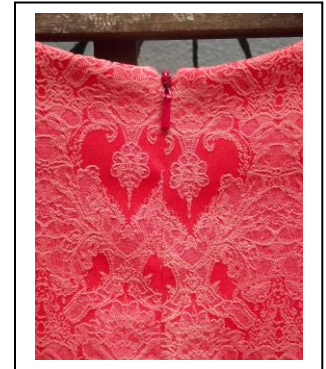
Short Class – Invisible Zipper

Something we get asked about regularly in store is how to put in an invisible zip. Once learnt they are easier than the standard zips and look very professional having only the slider revealed and no top stitching. You will need an invisible zip foot for your machine.

Right Turn Bag by Anna Maria Horner

Running over two sessions

This is a free Anna Maria Horner pattern through Janome.

A fun class that will give you plenty of opportunity to play with your fancy stitches, working with the turnover memory, elongation, lettering and memory system. You will be able to try out free motion stitching, the ribbon/sequin foot and similar. The bag has an applique design on the back and is fully lined. It is a great project to use up all those leftover cotton fabrics too!

Craft Classes

Smocked Child's Dress

Running over five sessions

Choose from either a gown up to six months or a simple short sleeved dress that has a peter pan collar from ages 6 months to 5 years, OR you may provide your own pattern.

Fabric will be required to be brought into us earlier than class commencement, to have the fabric pulled up for smocking, unless you have the equipment to complete yourself at home.

Learn to smock and sew the complete dress. Extra homework may be required in between the weekly sessions.

Overlocking Classes

Beginners – Book Cover

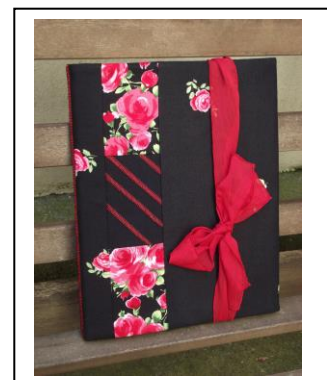
This class is perfect for anyone wishing to start using an overlocker or just does not feel very confident with setting tensions and threading. Firstly, we shall go through threading from scratch and analysing tensions using a different coloured thread for each looper and needle thread. The book cover project will include rolled hemming, narrow hem pin tucks and flat locking.

Intermediate – Zip Purse

Completely sewn on the overlocker except for the hole in the lining. Learn how to use a piping foot, gathering foot and how to put in a zip using your overlocker!

Advanced – Overlocker Cover

Running over two sessions

This class pushes you and your overlocker to the next level. It includes using the gathering attachment, cording foot and elastic attachment. Plus weaving strips of fabric, piping and flatlocking.

Cover Seam/Overlock Class – Beginners Vege Bags

This is a perfect project to gain more confidence with your overlocker and cover seam machine OR if you do not currently own a cover seam machine you may borrow one in class. You will practise threading and learn lots of tips of what to look for in terms of settings so you may be able to sew at home stress free!

Cover Seam/Overlock Class – T-Shirt Style

This class will have an emphasis on handling knit fabric with minimal alterations for fit.

Choose your own pattern and fabric.

The t-shirt will be overlocked together using a 4-thread stitch and altering the differential feed if required.

A binder on the cover seam machine can be used to bind the neck, with the hems also cover seamed.

This is ideally suited to those who already own both an overlocker and cover seam machine however, there will be at least one cover seam machine to use during class.

Christmas Panel Class

This could be an advent calendar panel, stocking panel or other Christmas panel.
