## *Dressmaking Classes*

### **General Dressmaking Classes**

**Running over four terms**

Get help with your garment cutting, construction and fit as you create unique pieces of clothing. You will need to supply your own pattern/fabric/notions of your choice and bring along your sewing machine.

Numbers are limited to 8 per class, please book early to avoid disappointment.

**\$140 per 8-week term.**

Choose from these sessions; Tuesday afternoons, Tuesday nights, Wednesday mornings, Wednesday afternoons, Wednesday nights or Thursday mornings.

## *Sewing Machine Classes*

### **Short Classes**

These Classes are predominately sample based and therefore you will not be creating a project but instead a series of samples and notes to keep for further reference.

You will learn more about the features of your machine model at the same time as learning how to use different machine accessories.

If you own a Janome machine, the feet/accessories could be loaned to you during class. Please ask upon class enrolment.

### **Sewing Machine Maintenance Session**

Bring your machine along to learn how to clean and oil. We shall also talk about trouble shooting ideas with threading, needles and bobbin case.

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### **Learn to Know Your Sewing Machine**

This will be a very basic beginners class aimed for anyone who has hardly used a sewing machine or perhaps never at all and would like to borrow one of our machines for the session. You will create a small project to take home.

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## **Pockets – In Seam and Welt**

Learn to sew two different pocket methods, the in seam or side seam pocket and the welt pocket style. You will create samples in class to take home.

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## **Hem Finishes**

You will create samples to take home of different hem finishes utilising your sewing machine stitches and feet/accessories. If you own a Janome machine, you may borrow feet during the session. The class fee will include all your supplies.

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## **Seam Finishes**

Learn about different seam finishes such as a french seam, flat fell, bound and more. If you own a Janome machine you can utilise some feet and accessories to make seam finishing easier. You will create samples to take home.

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## **Zippers - Invisible and Standard**

During this class you will sew in an invisible zipper, using the concealed zip foot and hinged zip foot to close the seam. We shall also explore some methods of using a standard zip.

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## **Buttonholes and Button Sew Foot**

Take the fear out of buttonholes! We shall start with the standard buttonhole and foot that comes with your machine, then progress onto knit fabric buttonhole styles and a welt or bound buttonhole. Little tips will be given to be able to create a neat and stress free buttonhole. The session will end with a play with the button sew foot, stitching buttons on my machine.

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## **Quilting – Walking Foot and Free Motion Feet**

Learn how to use the walking foot and get a taste of the free motion feet to create a simple quilted small mat.

The neckline of a garment can be a make or break point. For this short class we will concentrate on a simple faced cotton neckline, a bound neckline and then a knit/stretch neckline.

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## Machine Sewing Full Day Classes

### Knicker Class

Making your own underwear is a way to get the fit and style as you would like, save money and have items that are of a higher quality that lasts. There will be three styles to choose from and different methods shown on how to attach elastic and stretch lace. If you have a cover seam machine, this could also be used alongside your sewing machine. Come prepared to make more than one pair during the day.

This handy bag can store your current project or anything you like at all!

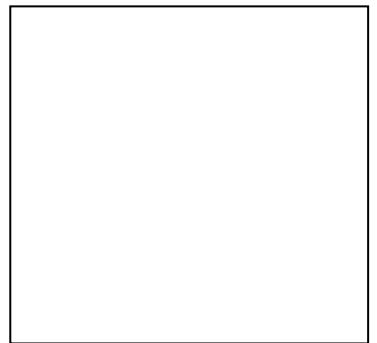
With fancy stitching and multi pockets, binding and carry handle, this bag not only looks great but is very functional too.

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# *Overlocking Classes*

## **Short Classes**

An opportunity to learn more about your overlocker without investing too much time.

Feet will be available to borrow during class if you own a Janome or recent Babylock model.

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### **Overlocker Basics**

Working through the basics of threading, tension, navigating corners, 3 thread, 4 thread and more.

You will create samples to take home with you.

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### **Feet Overview – Rolled Hemming, Cording Foot and Flatlocking**

Learn how to use the cording foot with the rolled hem stitch and how to flatlock (decorative and functional).

You will create samples to take home with you.

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## Feet Overview – Piping and Gathering Attachment

Find out how the piping foot can be used to attach piping or even a zip, along with gathering a single piece of fabric or gathering onto another flat piece of fabric to make a seam.

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## Day Classes

### Beginners – Fabric Basket

Become more confident with using your overlocker. We shall firstly go through threading and what to look for when analysing tension. You will then learn how to flatlock, create a three thread narrow pin tuck, use a 4 thread overlock stitch and a wide 3 thread stitch.

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### Beginners – Fabric Book Cover

Become more confident with using your overlocker. We shall firstly go through threading and what to look for when analysing tension. You will then learn how to flatlock, roll hem, use a 4 thread overlock stitch and a wide 3 thread stitch.

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### Intermediate – Zip Purse

Completely sewn on the overlocker except for the hole in the lining. Learn how to use a piping foot, gathering foot and how to put in a zip using your overlocker!

## **Advanced – Overlocker and/or Cover Seam Bag**

### **Running over two sessions**

This class pushes you and your overlocker to the next level. It includes using the gathering attachment, cording foot and elastic attachment. Plus weaving strips of fabric, piping and flatlocking.

If you own a cover seam machine, the project can be adjusted so that you are using both machines.

Numbers are limited to 6 per class, please book early to avoid disappointment.

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## *Cover Seam Machine Classes*

### **Short Classes**

**NEW** short classes to help you either get started with your cover seam machine or help give you more confidence to explore.

### **Learn to know your Cover Seam Machine**

This session will cover threading, how to press, pin and guide your fabric hem and using the different stitches – 3 needle, 2 needle and chain stitch.

This will be a sample based class.
